We were grateful to the schools that were able find time for cricket sessions Due to exams and holidays we carried more sessions at the hub than schools.





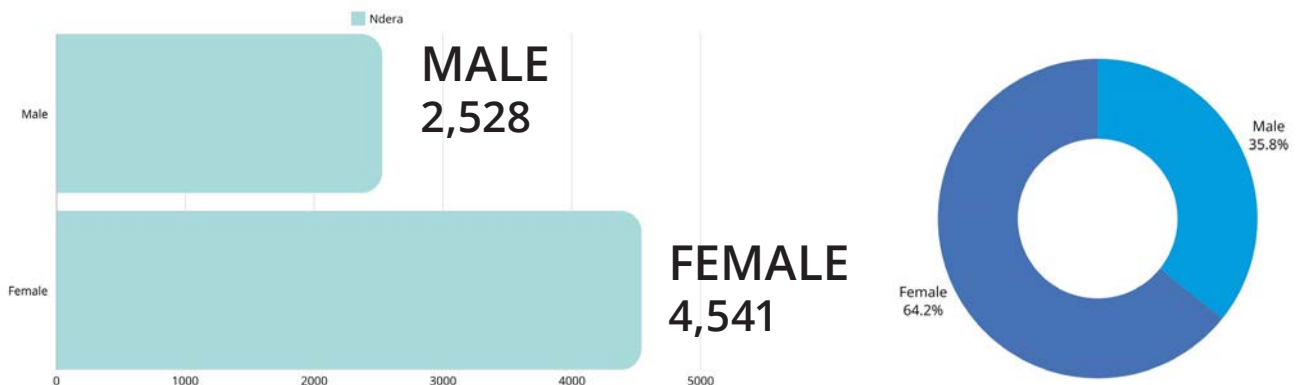
