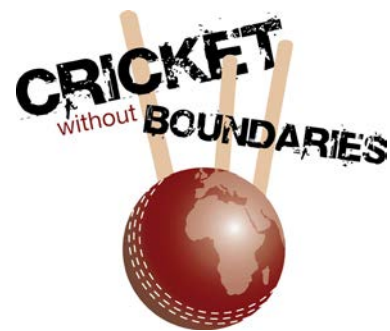

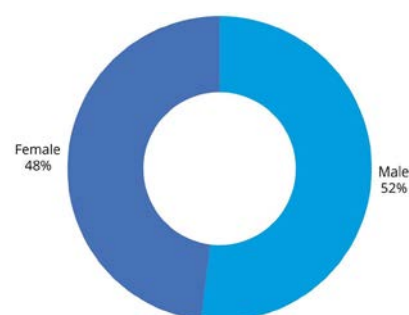
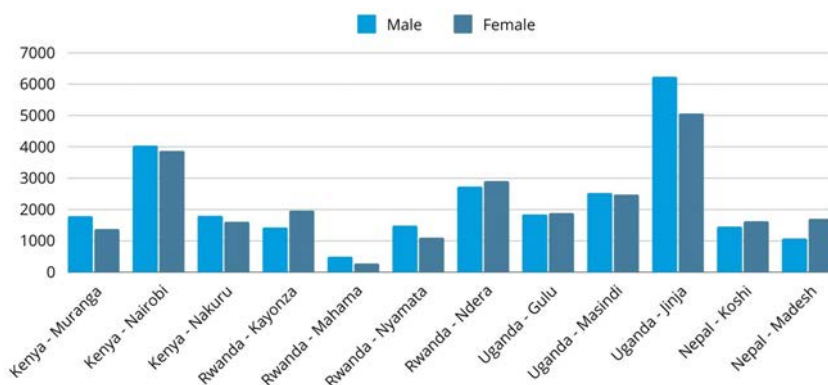

- 3 boys from the Nakuru hub selected to represent Kenya u19s

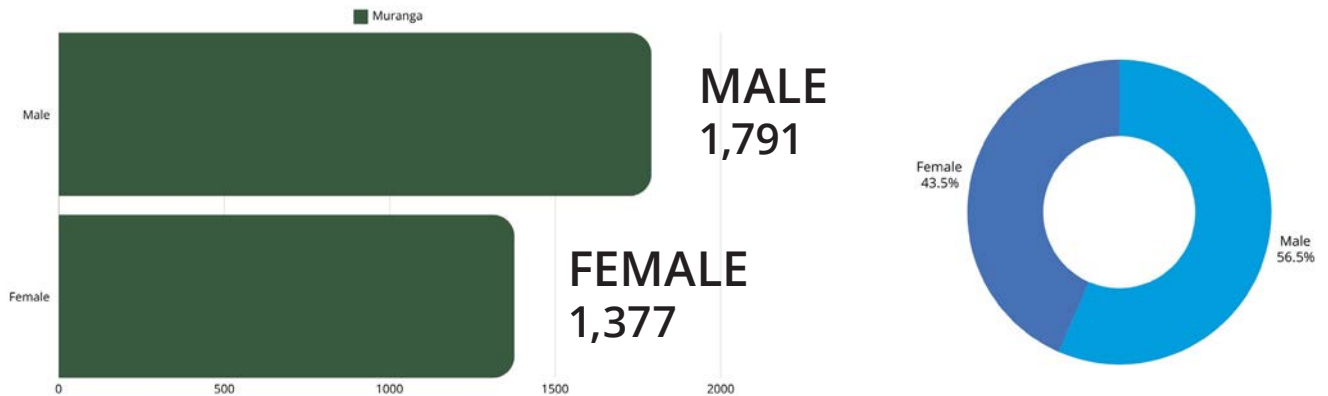
