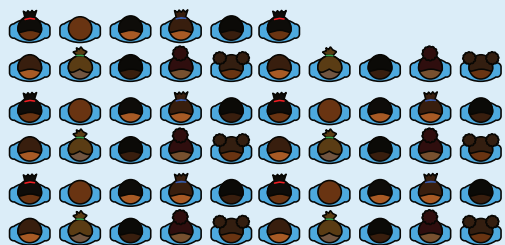

developing new activities that promote discussion about HIV, stigma, and gender equality and then incorporate the resulting work into cricket skills and games.



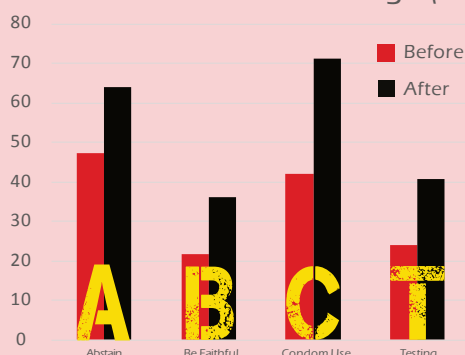

UGANDA

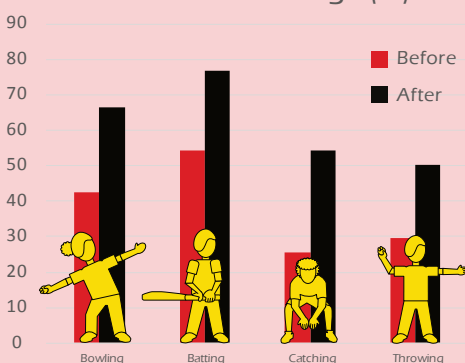
Before and **After** every session we asked participants to name 4 ways to prevent HIV, and to name 3 cricket skills.

Cricket Knowledge (%)



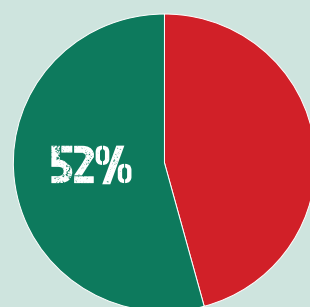

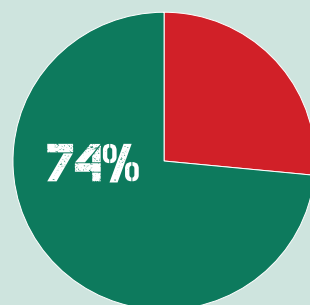
